All HomeCrest cabinets meet or exceed the requirements and specifications of ANSI A161.1/2000 and are certified in accordance with KCMA specifications. HomeCrest takes great care in the selection and application of materials to give your cabinetry a fine furniture finish. Solid wood frames are finished with stain and a durable catalyzed varnish. By nature, hardwoods expand and contract with temperature and humidity level changes and over time seam lines will form at front frame joints. Additionally all surfaces will be affected by exposure to sunlight, smoke, household cleaners and other substances making it difficult to match existing cabinetry at a later date. This is especially true on light or frost finishes. These occurrences are normal and not the result of defects in materials or workmanship. On thermofoil lines HomeCrest recommends providing a 1-1/2" clearance between thermofoil surfaces and any heat source. This is especially important when installing ovens with self-cleaning features. Due to continuous product improvements, specifications are subject to change without notice. Colors depicted in printed photographs may not reflect actual finish color.
